Shut-down work – Continued

New stands have been provided for the Gaol bells. These have hidden wheels so the bells can be easily moved, if required.

A stand is shortly to be proved for the bell of HMS Blake, which was donated to the Museum by St Mary's Church.

New donations to the Museum

We have been given an extensive collection of photographs of West Country shipping. They are mostly from the past 50 years, and, as well as Bridgwater, Dunball and Combwich, include Watchet, Exmouth, Teignmouth, and Falmouth. When we have sorted the images out and listed them we will pass the non-local material to other museums.

We have also been given a wall-clock, presented to Mr Harry Burge, late Verger at St Mary's on the occasion of his silver wedding in 1925. The gift was from the Vicar and congregation.

Digitisation

Equipment has been purchased to allow the digitisation of large-format images of up to A2 size (16.6in x 23.4in ; 42cm x 59.4cm). This will allow us to readily digitise bigger paintings, maps and newspaper pages. This has only been possible before with a hand-held camera, and with usually indifferent results.

Trifold leaflets

A stand has been purchased for the display of the trifold history leaflets. It will go in the Bridgwater Room and will hold around 30 different titles.

New Chairs

30 new chairs have been purchased for the meeting room. They are lighter than the 50 heavy ones they replace which have gone to the Town Hall. A curtain will be provided for the alcove where they are stored
